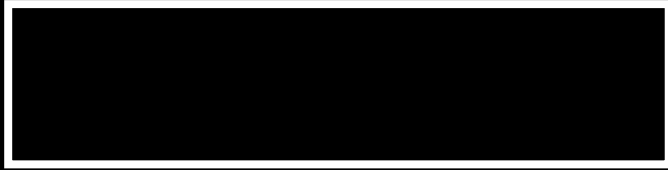




10 Things We Love about Redding

6 The Spinning Wheel Inn

The spinning wheel inn is one of Redding's most popular restaurants. They were rated in the readers choice best restaurants Connecticut Magazine 2017. They are known for their brunch and their Magic of Christmas show during the holidays.



1 Collis P. Huntington Park

Collis P. Huntington State Park is a public recreation area covering 1,017 acres for hunting, hiking, canoeing, & riding. The state park is noted for Anna Hyatt Huntington's sculptures of bears and wolves that welcome visitors at the park entrance.

2 Putnam Memorial State Park

Putnam Memorial State Park is a state-operated historic park and public recreation area. The state park preserves the site that Major General Israel Putnam chose as the winter encampment for his men during the American Revolutionary War.



7 Top Stone Park

Topstone is Redding's 280-acre park with a picturesque lake and sandy beach used for swimming & kayaking, plus nature trails and even a beach for dogs.

8 Community Garden

Redding's Park and Recreation Department administers the Community Garden for residents. They have 23 fenced in garden plots located behind the Historical Society on Route 107.



3 Mark Twain's Home

In 1908, Samuel Clemens, the author better known as Mark Twain, built himself an Italianate dream house called Stormfield. In 1923, his elaborate home burned to the ground. In its place, this similar mansion was built in 1925.



9 Lyrics Coffee House

The Lyrics music series features artists performing original music in a warm coffeehouse environment. Performances are held on the first Friday night of each month from 7:30-9:30 pm at the Redding Community Center from November through April.



4 Saugatuck Natural Falls

The Saugatuck Falls Natural Area is a forested park bisected by the Saugatuck River. This popular, natural attraction is the heart of Redding offers over five miles of beautiful trails and waterfalls.

5 Concerts on the Green

During June, July, and August, "Concerts on the Green" are held on the Redding Town Green from 6:00pm - 8:00pm. These family fun concerts are 100% funded by generous companies and private donations.



10 Public Schools

Redding's children are served by a blue-ribbon school system that is part of the Easton-Redding-Region 9 School District. The Redding Elementary School was awarded the prestigious PTA School of Excellence Award for 2015-17.
