4 Trumbull Library

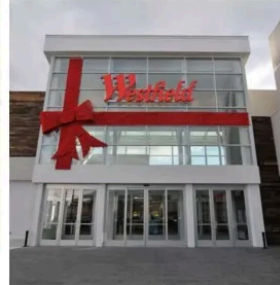
